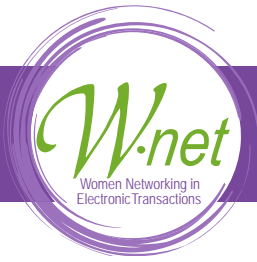
Legacy Sponsorship
